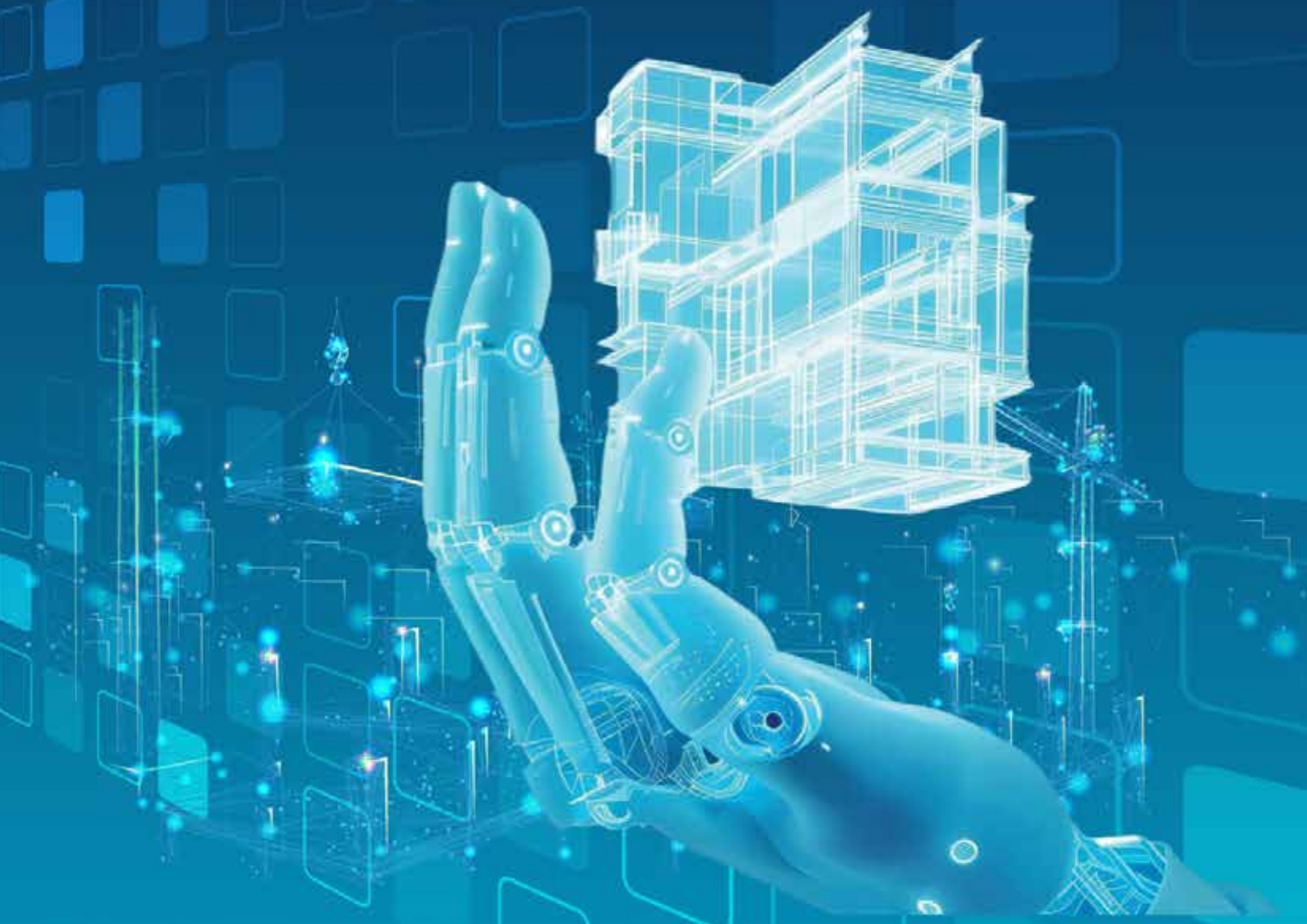

EVENT OVERVIEW

The global construction industry is entering a new phase of digital disruption as artificial intelligence, automation and smart technologies reshape project delivery, infrastructure development and asset management. In progressive innovation hubs such as Copenhagen, smart city initiatives, digital twins and AI-driven design are increasingly embedded into infrastructure, housing and urban development programmes. The European market is projected to grow at over 17% annually as investment in AI-enabled construction, robotics and digital platforms expands across public and private sectors.

At the same time, organisations face significant implementation and technical challenges. Data silos, interoperability gaps and cybersecurity risks continue to slow adoption, with nearly 68% of firms citing data security as a major concern and 55% identifying skills shortages as a key barrier to scaling AI solutions. High upfront costs, integration with legacy systems and evolving regulatory frameworks also require careful planning and governance. Despite these challenges, AI is delivering measurable outcomes—boosting productivity by up to 40–50%, reducing project costs by as much as 20% and improving schedule accuracy through predictive analytics and advanced planning tools. AI-driven BIM and generative design are also transforming design workflows, reducing initial design time by up to 70% while improving collaboration and risk visibility across stakeholders.

Beyond operational efficiency, the sector is witnessing significant business and investment opportunities across smart infrastructure, sustainable construction, robotics, modular and offsite manufacturing, as well as digital construction platforms. AI-enabled sustainability modelling is helping reduce building emissions by up to 20%, while automated safety monitoring systems are cutting accident rates and improving compliance. As digital ecosystems mature, construction firms, developers and technology providers are exploring new revenue models, partnerships and data-driven services that will redefine the future of the built environment. **AI & Smart Innovation in Construction** will bring together industry leaders, policymakers, engineers and technology innovators to explore the strategic, technical and commercial pathways needed to scale adoption, unlock value and build resilient, intelligent and sustainable infrastructure for the next generation.
